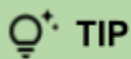

Equipment Requirements

- ☐ Mobile 2m/70cm radio (40W min)
- ☐ Spare fuses for mobile radio and cable (as necessary)
- ☐ Anderson Power Poles
 - ☐ Power pole to cigarette lighter
 - ☐ Power pole to alligator clip
 - ☐ Power pole extension cable
 - ☐ Power pole three way splitter
 - ☐ We recommend replacing the plug on your mobile radio with anderson power poles so it can be interchangeable with other radios within UCARES
